UPDATE - National Flight Academy and Space Camp

Unfortunately, due to budgetary constraints, we will not be able to fund tuition to the National Flight Academy or Space Camp this summer. We hope to resume offering these opportunities next summer. The **2024 Summer Training Guidance** was sent to the field on 02 FEB 24 and made available at Homeport>Advancement Training>Training Guidance. This is available on the Quarterdeck under the News and Info button. All cadets, parents, and volunteers should read it carefully to plan and prepare for a successful training season.

Staff Cadet Application Process - If you are a PO1 looking for a RT/NLO staff cadet leadership position (to meet the CPO qualification), you will need to let your chain of command know. This note will need to be in their approval process. Some trainings may have a separate process for these roles, so read the details carefully of each training. Cadet leadership roles are limited at each training.

Best practice for summer training sign-up - Please be cautious about requesting multiple trainings for your cadet with overlapping dates or that do not leave enough time for cadets to rest in between. We understand the desire for cadets to sign up for multiple trainings to ensure they get into their desired location; however, this creates heavy burdens on our volunteers at the unit and training locations.


