

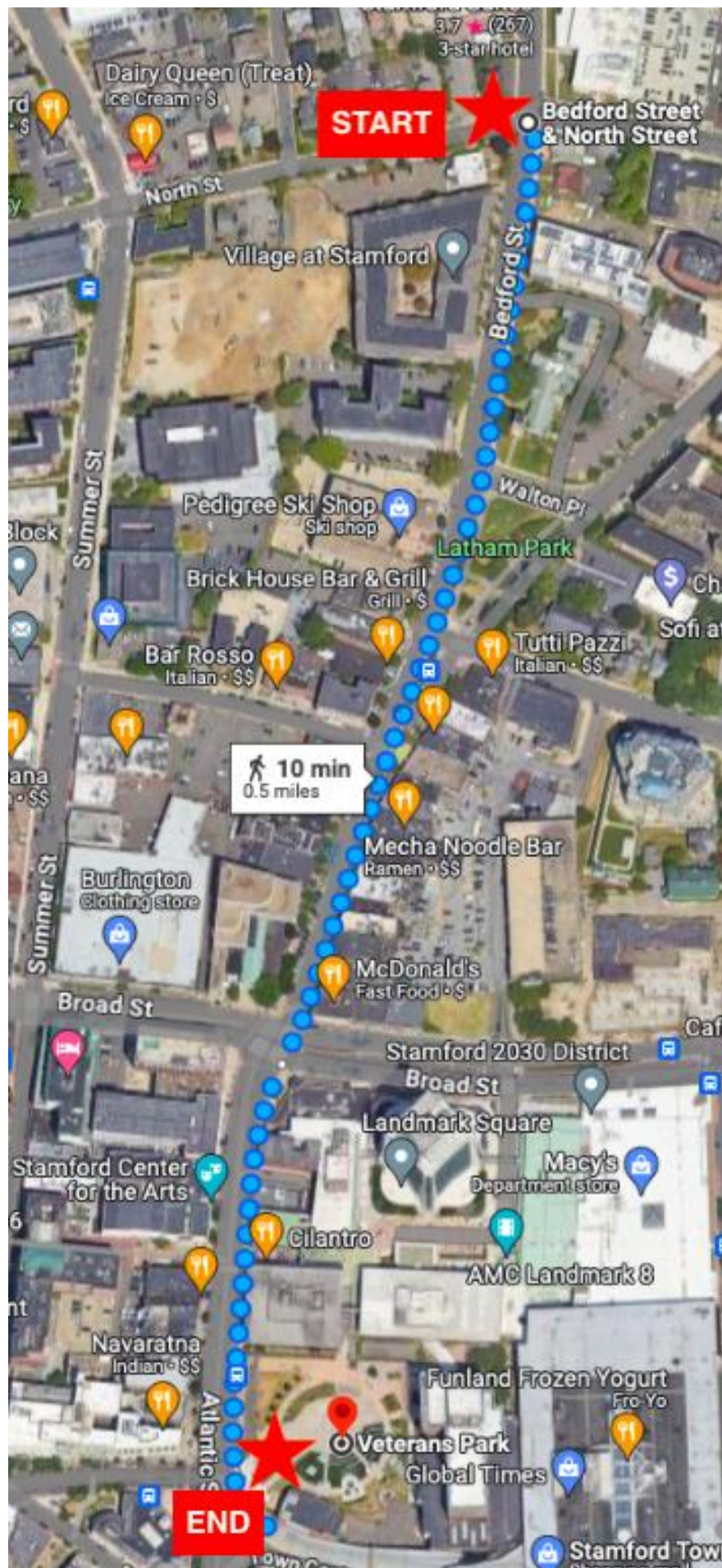
Stamford Veterans Day Parade & Ceremony

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

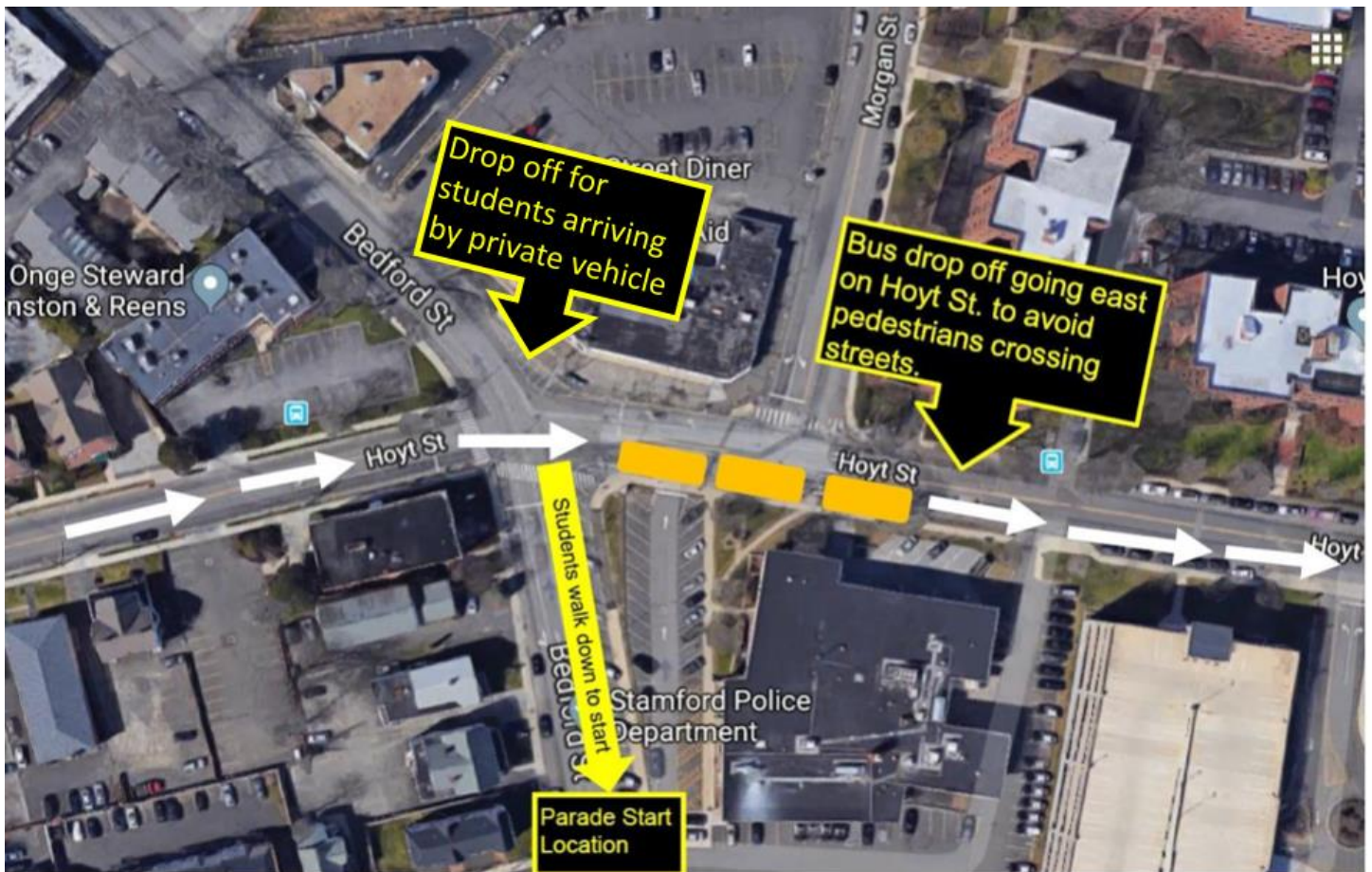
- Arrival Time: Between 11am-11:30am
- Parking: Bedford Street Garage, Bell Street Garage and Stamford Town Center (all are free on Sundays)
- Trolley for Veterans and Participants will run from Veterans Park to step-off staging area between 11am-11:30am
- Parade Route: step-off is Bedford at North Street, followed Bedford Street across Broad Street to Atlantic, ending at Veterans Memorial Park.
- Parade Step-Off: 12pm, Ceremony at Veterans Park immediately following the parade.
- Porta-John restrooms will be available at step-off and at Veterans Memorial Park.

BUS & PARTICIPANT DROP OFF LOCATION

School buses should drop participants off at the corner of Bedford and Hoyt Street. Buses can then stage at Edith Sherman Drive after dropping off and for the duration of the parade.

If you are staging on NORTH STREET: Please enter via Prospect Street so your vehicle is staged in the correct direction.



END OF PARADE/CEREMONY

Participants staying for the ceremony should pull onto Main Street (at Dunkin' across from Veterans Park) and use reserved meter spaces.

Participants NOT staying for the ceremony can continue down Atlantic Street to either depart or meet buses at Edith Sherman Drive
