### **DEADLINE DATE: 15 APRIL 2024**

<u>BILLETS</u>: Billets have been reserved, first-come, first served. <u>All hands must bring their own linens or sleeping bags.</u>

<u>COST</u>: \$75.00 per person, payable to "NSCC." <u>Payment in full, must accompany your reservation</u>; all bills are paid in advance. One unit check must accompany your reservations for all hands attending.

UNIFORM OF THE DAY: Please Read "Reef Points" Enclosed

<u>ARRIVAL</u>: ALL UNITS MUST ARRIVE <u>AT THE GATE, AS A UNIT</u> AND <u>ALL DRIVERS</u> MUST BE INCLUDED ON YOUR RESERVATION FORM(S).

\*\* ALL ADULT DRIVERS MUST BE INCLUDED ON THE MATRIX AND WILL UNDERGO A BACKGROUND CHECK IN ADVANCE\*\*

INSTRUCTIONS: <u>ALL</u> UNITS MUST COMPLY WITH <u>ALL</u> OF THE INSTRUCTIONS ENCLOSED; NO EXCEPTIONS. <u>PLEASE NOTE CONSIDERATIONS FOR SECURITY ACCESS TO THE RESERVATION. Use the forms provided and do not submit "homegrown" or custom editions of the forms.</u>

ID Cards and complete service records are required for all hands.

Please complete the enclosed reservation forms and <u>return them by the deadline date;</u> NO RESERVATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THAT DATE.

ARRIVAL TIME: no earlier than 1900. Training will commence upon arrival of all units.

- \* The "Flagship Competition" weekend is a competition. It is also an opportunity for officers and cadets to convene in friendly camaraderie and an opportunity to instill self-confidence, pride and teamwork. While attendance is good <u>preparation</u> in many ways for recruit training, it is not, however, recruit training.
- \* As has been the requirement since 1991, your unit fees must accompany your rosters; your fee must equal the number of personnel listed on your rosters. We cannot-will not-"front" the cost. No personal checks; a single unit check for all hands must accompany the reservation.
- \* DUE TO SECURITY REQUIREMENTS, All units must arrive at the Main gate, together as one unit;
- \* DUE TO SECURITY REQUIREMENTS, all personnel attending the weekend must arrive on Friday with your unit; with the exception of parental retrieval on Sunday afternoon, no additional personnel will be permitted after Friday night;
- \* <u>DUE TO SECURITY REQUIREMENTS</u>, Use the MMR Access Roster Only; do not submit "home-grown" versions. <u>Include</u> the names, <u>DOB</u> and license number for all <u>ADULTS</u> attending, including all drivers;
- \*\*DUE TO SECURITY REQUIREMENTS: ALL ADULT DRIVERS MUST BE INCLUDED ON THE MATRIX, MUST BE TYPED AND WILL UNDERGO A BACKGROUND CHECK;
- \*  $\underline{\textit{DUE}}$  TO  $\underline{\textit{SECURITY}}$  REQUIREMENTS, only those personnel attending the weekend will be permitted to attend the dance. No Guests will be permitted on the Reservation for attending the dance;
- \* Due to the number of attendees, the requirement for advance payment, billeting assignments, watch bills, team schedule assignments, certificates, etc., please forward your reservations by the deadline. As always, we invite units who have not previously attended, therefore, as announced, no late billet reservations will be accepted. NO FAXES, FEDEX or personal deliveries will be accepted after the deadline. As announced in 2002, units whose rosters arrive late, will be assessed 5 points per day from their total score;
- \* If you have a League Cadet contingent competing within the Sea Cadet unit, not as a separate unit, PLEASE ensure that information is noted for scheduling purposes of events;
- \* Please ensure familiarization with the enclosed profiles, note the updated "Honor Guard" Drill card to reflect conformity with the USMC "Manual", the definitive text for drill;
- \* Officers are welcome to judge any event; no one should feel they can't select a particular event because someone else has "ownership" of that event. Rotation of judges is good experience and more important, promotes objectivity. Please include officers' choices on the judges' reservation form; this is required, due to the number of personnel in attendance, and the requirement to schedule concurrent League and Sea Cadet competitions;
- \* The Uniform of the Day is established after consultation with the combined commanders of the Mass. Military Reservation. The Uniform of the Day for cadet attendees is NWU. The inspection will be included in 2022, therefore dress blue uniforms are necessary. The uniform of the day for Competitions will be the standard working uniform and will consist of one of: NWU's. All cadets from a unit must come in the same uniform; however, all cadets will be accepted providing they are in one of the approved uniforms. Attending Adult personnel may wear either the Khaki Work Uniform or NWU during competitions. Note: all uniforms need to be proper according to USNSCC/USNLCC regulations having all flashes, nametapes, and rank devices.
- $\star$  The weather on Cape Cod is variable, therefore it is recommended that all cadets bring canteens and sunscreen in order to be prepared for warm weather;
- $^{\star}$  In order to ensure accurate time recording and a sufficient supply of stopwatches, we ask that each unit provide one stopwatch;
- \* As announced in 2001, units whose cadets engage in unprofessional activities such as theft, "capturing" unit flags, fighting, changing watches or billeting assignments, being absent from watch, etc. will be assessed 10 points from their unit total score.
- \* As has been the custom since 1991, any complaints or concerns must be addressed on the Comment Sheets provided with the weekend or addressed to the host, at the time of concern, not after the conclusion of the weekend.
- \*Submit all the forms provided. Do not submit "homegrown", unit-created forms.

For 32 years the Annual "Flagship Competition" has included a dance. Attire has always been a topic among CO's and cadets alike. While it has been decided to allow cadets to enjoy the festivities in CIVILIAN ATTIRE, nevertheless, with this privilege is an understanding and agreement that must be met. The detailed guidelines below outline what will not be accepted attire.

### **CADETS WILL NOT WEAR**

- "SHORT SHORTS", SKIRTS (see below);
- TANK TOPS, MUSCLE SHIRTS, "A-SHIRTS", ETC.;
- RIPPED/TORN CLOTHING OF ANY KIND;
- LEGGINGS;
- HIGH OR MILITARY STYLE BOOTS;
- SANDALS/SLIPPERS ("UGG BOOTS" ARE ACCEPTABLE);
- BELLY SHIRTS OR ANY CLOTHING EXPOSING THE BODY;
- PAJAMAS OF ANY KIND;
- LARGE OR DANGLING EARINGS;
- WALLET CHAINS.

\*SHORTS AND SKIRTS ARE ALLOWED; SHORTS AND SKIRTS MUST NOT EXCEED ABOVE THE FINGER TIP IF ONE WERE TO EXTEND THEIR FINGERS AT THE POSITION OF ATTENTION

Directions to Mass. Military Reservation ("Joint Base Cape Cod") (Otis ANGB, Camp Edwards, CG Air Station Cape Cod, 6th SWS)

### From the North

- --Rte 3 south toward Cape Cod;
- -- At Sagamore Rotary, bear right onto Rte. 6 & 28 (do not go over Bridge);
- --Follow Rte 6 & 28 toward Buzzards Bay (Canal is on your left);
- -- As you approach Buzzards Bay rotary, stay to the right—do not go around the rotary);
- --Follow Rte. 28 south toward Falmouth—bear right onto the ramp for Bourne Bridge;
- --Follow directions in the box below.

### From the South

- --Follow Rte 95 to Providence;
- -- In Providence, follow Rte 195 East;
- --Follow exit for Rte. 25/495 in Wareham;
- --Follow Rte. 25 directly to Bourne Bridge;
- --Follow directions in the box below.
- --Go over Bourne Bridge, and follow Rte 28 South toward Falmouth;
- --At Pocasset Rotary, go 3/4 way around, and bear right for entrance to the Mass. Military Reservation ("Joint Base Cape Cod");
- --Follow this road (Connery Ave.) to the Main Gate;
- --After passing through the Main Gate, continue on Connery Ave. to flashing light, at 4-way intersection;
- -- Turn right on Turpentine Road;
- --Follow Turpentine to flashing light;
- --Directions to the appropriate cantonment area will be provided at this intersection
